NHS-funded reablement care typically runs for up to 6 weeks after discharge. We help families bridge the gap that often follows before long-term council support is confirmed.

IS HOSPITAL STEP-DOWN CARE RIGHT FOR YOU?

- A loved one has been discharged from hospital under the NHS 'Discharge to Assess' pathway and needs support at home during recovery
- NHS-funded reablement care is ending, or about to end, and a longer-term council assessment hasn't been completed yet
- You want continuity of care — the same familiar carer, rather than a rotating team, during a vulnerable recovery period
- There's a real risk of a care gap between NHS support ending and council-funded care beginning
